

PRINCIPLES OF INCLUSION



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- Every person with disabilities belongs in the community
- People with disabilities should be included in the regular housing and work environments and activities offered by the community



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- People with disabilities should be supported to live in their local communities
- The housing options for people with disabilities should be characterised by the standards of family type living



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- The development of relationships between people with disabilities and other members of society should be supported
- It is of key importance that people with disabilities participate in the life of the community and have the opportunity to develop skills needed for community living



PRINCIPLES OF INCLUSION

- It is important to include people with disabilities and their parents in the creation, support provision and evaluation of community based services
